# **Content Planning**

Every successful AI project starts with **verus**, a truthgrounded clarity.

# Define Your Message

What do you need to communicate? Is it a product feature? A process explanation? A client solution?

## Your First Step:

- · Identify the concept or problem you're addressing
- · Break it into 3-4 key points or stages
- Ask yourself: What would make this concept clear in short video segments?

**Example:** Start with topics you're passionate about—it's easier to guide AI when you care deeply about the subject matter.

# **Identify Perspectives**

Who needs to understand this? Consider 2-4 different viewpoints or use cases.

## Perspective Checklist:

- · Each represents distinct stakeholder or scenario
- · Clear differentiation between viewpoints
- · Relevant role in your demonstration
- · Can highlight benefits, challenges, or solutions

**Example:** For a software platform demo, we used: a frustrated legacy user, an enthusiastic early adopter, and a skeptical decision-maker—each revealing different value propositions.

## Structure a Presentation

Create anchor points (major concepts) with supporting segments between them.

### Framework

- 1. Hook (address pain point immediately)
- 2. Build context (3-4 brief explanations)
- 3. Demonstrate solution
- 4. Highlight outcomes or benefits
- 5. (Extra) Make back-up material for the B-roll

Keep segments under 8 seconds for maximum retention and easier AI generation.

# **Creating Your Visuals**

# Craft Image Prompts

Quality starts with clear visual foundations. Be specific! Essential Elements:

- Shot type: "Medium shot, landscape orientation"
- Subject: Professional attire, expression, posture
- Setting: "Office background" or "minimalist studio"
- · Lighting: "Professional lighting" or "natural office"
- · Style: "Corporate professional" or "startup casual"

## Sample Prompt:

"Medium shot of confident product manager in business casual attire, gesturing while explaining concept, against neutral office background, professional lighting, contemporary business style"

# Generate Visual Assets

Use your detailed prompts in AI image tools

## Quality Checklist:

- · Clear, professional appearance
- Consistent style across all segments
- Composition style for video conversion
- Clean, uncluttered backgrounds

# Prepare for the Video!

Before converting images to video, optimize!

### <u>Pre-Video Steps:</u>

- · Use image expansion (infill) tools for wider framing
- Refine any visual inconsistencies (logos, pixels)
- Ensure the setting supports your message
- Maintain originals and alternative versions

# **B-Roll Philosophy**

Don't delete "imperfect" generations! The slightly off-angle shot or alternative expression may be:

- · Perfect transition footage
- · Effective supporting visual
- · Ideal for a different project entirely

Storage is cheap! Re-generating identical content is time-consuming! Perfection may never arrive!

# Images to Video

Use AI video tools with consistent parameters. **Generate multiple takes** of critical segments—variations provide editing flexibility! Use an opening phrase for all video prompts in the same project for visual consistency across all clips.

**Video Generation Template:** "Create a professional presentation segment [role/perspective] from the provided image speaking directly to viewer, [specific gestures or emphasis], [tone: explanatory/enthusiastic]"

## Add Narration & Context

Most AI tools now support voice generation or synchronization and replacement of your narrations.

## Common Voicing Options:

- · Al voice generation with professional parameters
- · Record your own narration for authenticity
- · Use text overlays for data points or technical details

**Voice Parameter Example:** "Professional American accent, clear explanatory tone, speaking directly to business audience with an authentic demeanor."

# Edit, Log & Iterate

Capture your methodology before moving on.

## Editing Essentials:

- · Include text overlays for key metrics or concepts
- · Review pacing (8 seconds max per segment)

## Archive for Future Projects:

- · Save successful prompt templates
- Note effective approaches and pitfalls, why did you make specific editing choices or variation testing?
- · Share insights with your team!

**Ask yourself:** If a colleague needed to replicate this approach, what would they need to know? If I came back to this in 3 weeks, would I understand what I did?
